

## REDEVELOPMENT OF THE SCHUMAN ROUNDABOUT

Dear resident,

In addition to the works currently underway on avenue de la Joyeuse Entrée, a new phase of works will start **on 11 March 2024** on **rue de la Loi** (between the bridge over the chaussée d'Etterbeek and boulevard Charlemagne).

### Planned works and planning

This intervention will take place in 4 phases: Depending on the phase in progress, diversions will be put in place. We thank you in advance for your patience and cooperation during these essential works.

- From 11/03 to 29/03** : Adaptation of the Loi/Taciturne junction. The higher part of rue du Taciturne is closed to traffic. To allow access to the Charlemagne building, the section of rue du Taciturne between rue Joseph II and rue de la Loi will be a two-way street during this phase of the works and the access from rue de la Loi will be closed.
- From 08/04 to 13/05** : Narrowing of the insertion lane of the side road coming from the Schuman roundabout in order to create a new pavement with tree planters and a plateau on the Charlemagne boulevard. Rue du Taciturne will temporarily be a two-way street during this phase.
- From 13/05 to 10/06** : Pavement of the footpath next to the Charlemagne building and creation of the plateau at the beginning of the Charlemagne boulevard.
- From 10/06 to 26/06** : Creation of the plateau on rue du Taciturne, and creation of the pavement and cycle path along the Jardin de la Vallée du Maelbeek. Rue du Taciturne is once again one-way towards Rue Joseph II.

### Practicalities

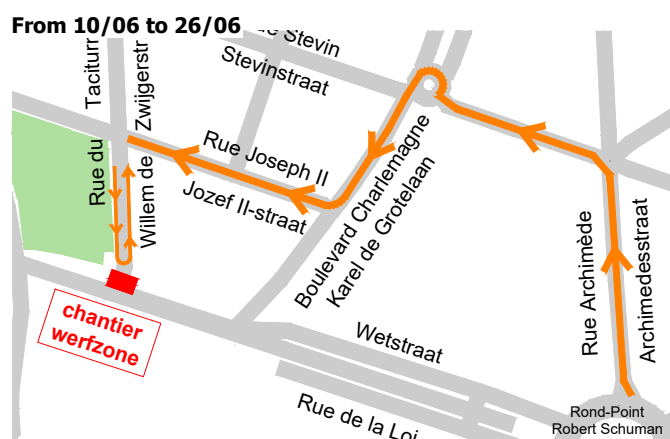
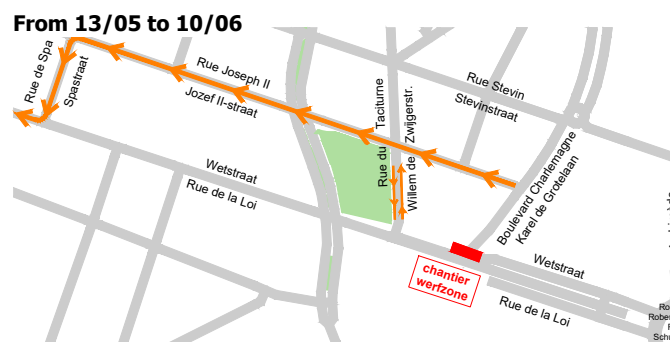
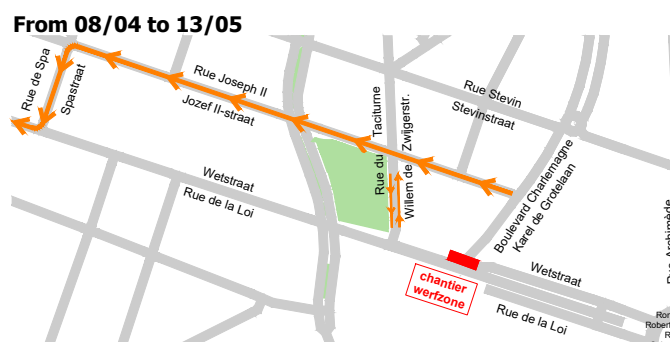
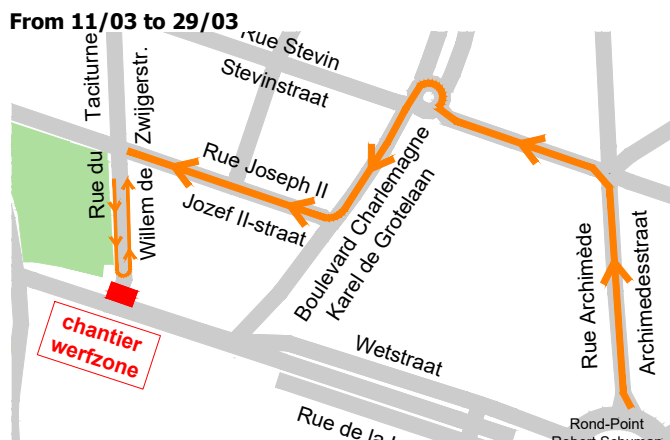
**From 11 March, the speed limit at the exit of the Loi tunnel will be adjusted for motorists.** Pedestrian access and cyclist traffic will be maintained at all times.

### Accessibility

Access to buildings and garages will be maintained at all times, as will the passage for emergency service. Deliveries and removals within the site zone remain possible after contacting the ombudsman.

### Public transportation

Neither the operation of the buses (STIB) nor the Schuman train underground station will be affected by the works.
